REQUIREMENTS

For appointment to this grade, a candidate must have: -

1. Certificate in any of the following disciplines: Kenya Enrolled Nurse, Kenya Enrolled Community Health Nurse, Kenya Enrolled Midwife, Kenya Enrolled Psychiatric Nurse or Enrolled Nurse/Midwife; **OR** Diploma in any of the following disciplines: Kenya Community Health Nursing, Kenya Registered Nursing, Kenya Registered Midwifery, Kenya Registered Nursing/Midwifery or Kenya Registered Nursing/Mental Health and Psychiatry from a recognized institution;

2. Registration Certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Kenya; **OR** Enrolment Certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Kenya;
3. Valid practicing license from Nursing Council of Kenya;
4. Certificate in Computer Application Skills from a recognized institution.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

An Officer at this level will work under the guidance of a Senior Officer and will carry out the following:

1. Assessing, planning, implementing nursing interventions and evaluating patient's outcomes;
2. Providing appropriate healthcare service including Integrated Management of Childhood Illnesses (IMCI), immunization, PMTCT, ante-natal care and delivery, providing health education and Counseling to patients/clients and community on identified health needs ;
3. Referring patients and clients appropriately;
4. Facilitating patients' admission and initiating discharge plans;

5. Maintaining records on patients'/clients health condition and care;
6. Ensuring a tidy and safe clinical environment;
7. Collecting and compiling data.

REQUIREMENTS

For appointment to this grade, a candidate must have: -

1. Be a Kenyan Citizen;
2. Diploma in Clinical Medicine and Surgery or Clinical Medicine and Community Health;
3. Must be Registered and Licensed with the Clinical Officers Council; and
4. Computer literate.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Taking history, examining, diagnosing and treating patients' common ailments at an outpatient or inpatient health facility;
2. Implementing Community Health Care activities in liaison with other health workers;
3. Guiding and counseling patients, clients and staff on health issues;
4. Sensitizing patients and clients on preventive and promotive health;
5. Carrying out minor surgical procedures as per training and skill:

6. Collecting and compiling Clinical data; and
7. Referring patients and clients to appropriate health facilities.
