

REPORT OF THE HEALTH FACILITIES PROGRAM –LAMU COUNTY

Getting proper health services especially for the poor in this country was a nightmare since this country got self-independent.

But after the new down of the 2013 new constitution common mwannchi now is getting services almost at his doorstep.

Health service is among the sector which its function has been devolved and now referral hospital, health centers, and dispensaries are managed by the county government.

In Lamu County places like Ishakani which is bordering Somalia, community living in that area had to travel long distance up to Kiunga to seek medical attention.

But now community living in Ishakani especially women are happy and appreciated for the services which they are getting from Ishakani dispensary.

Since the year 2013 Lamu County has spent over 63 million Kenyan shillings to construct health facilities across the county.

Uziwa, Moa, Tewe, Kastakakairu, Maisha Masha and Ishakani are dispensaries which are fully equipped, furnished and operational with VIP toilet.

Manda dispensary was renovated and fenced while Sinambio was renovated with VIP toilet.

Bargoni dispensary in Hindi ward and Kiangwe in Basuba ward its construction is completed with VIP toilet are waiting to be officially opened and operate.
