- 1.1 The County Government of Lamu invites sealed tenders for the **Installations of Desalination Plant at Kiunga, Kizingitini and Ndau.**
- 1.2 Interested eligible candidates may obtain further information and inspect tender documents from the Supply Chain Management office located at located at **COUNTY HEADQUARTERS at MOKOWE**, during normal working hours or visit our website at www.lamu.go.ke.
- 1.3 A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested candidates upon payment of non-refundable fees of (Kshs.1, 000.00) in cash or Bankers Cheque payable to **COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU, Kenya Commercial Bank – Lamu Branch, Acc NO. 1140750615 or Equity Bank – Lamu Branch Acc. - 1.4 Prices quoted should be net inclusive of all taxes, must be in Kenya shillings and shall remain valid for 120 days from the closing date of tender.
- 1.1 1.5 Completed tender documents are to be enclosed in plain sealed envelopes marked with Tender name and reference number and deposited in the Tender Box at Supply Chain Management office at LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT office located at White House at County Headquarters or to be addressed to **(COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU P.O BOX 74-80500 LAMU** so as to be received on or before **Thursday 16TH May, 2019 at 11.00 a.m.**
- 1.6 Tenders will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of the candidates or their representatives who choose to attend at Supply Chain Management Office in Lamu.

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1.7 All bid documents shall be serialized/paginated from the first to the last page.

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INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS.

1.1 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT as defined in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract invites tenders for Installation of Desalination plant as described in the tender document. The successful **Tenderer(s) SHOULD BE WILLING TO ENTER INTO Three (3) year FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT WITH LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR WORKS OF SIMILAR NATURE)** and should complete the Works by the Intended Completion Date specified in the said Appendix.

1.2 Tenderers shall include the following information and documents with their tenders, unless otherwise stated:

1.3 The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

1.4 The Tenderer, at the Tenderer's own responsibility and risk, is encouraged to visit and examine the Site of the Works and its surroundings, and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the tender and entering into a contract for construction of the Works. The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Tenderer's own expense.

1.5 The procurement entity's employees, committee members, board members and their relative (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the tender.

1.6 The price to be charged for the tender document shall not exceed Kshs.5,000/=

1.7 The County Government of Lamu shall allow the tenderer to review the tender document free of charge before purchase.

2. Tender Documents

2.1 The complete set of tender documents comprises the documents listed here below and any addenda issued in accordance with clause 2.4 here below:-

- (a) These instructions to Tenderers

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- (b) Form of Tender
- (c) Conditions of Contract and Appendix to Conditions of Contract
- (d) Specifications
- (e) Drawings
- (f) Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates (whichever is applicable)
- (g) Other materials required to be filled and submitted in accordance with these Instructions and Conditions

2.2 The Tenderer shall examine all instructions, forms and specifications in the tender documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the tender documents may result in rejection of his tender.

2.3 Prospective Tenderer making inquiries of the tendering documents may notify Lamu County Government in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile at the address indicated in the letter of invitation to tender. Lamu County Government will respond to any request for clarification received earlier than seven [7] days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. Copies of the Lamu County Government responses will be forwarded to all persons issued with tendering documents, including a description of the inquiry, but without identifying its source.

2.4 Before the deadline for submission of tenders, The County Government of Lamu may modify the tendering documents by issuing addenda. Any addendum thus issued shall be part of the tendering documents and shall be communicated in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile to all Tenderers. Prospective Tenderers shall acknowledge receipt of each addendum in writing to the County Government of Lamu

2.5 To give prospective Tenderers reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their tenders, The County Government of Lamu shall extend, as necessary, the deadline for submission of tenders in accordance with clause 4.2 here below.

3. Preparation of Tenders

3.1 All documents relating to the tender and any correspondence shall be in English Language.

3.2 The tender submitted by the Tenderer shall comprise the following:-
(a) The Tender;

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- (b) Tender Security;
 - (c) Priced Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates for lump-sum Contracts
 - (d) Any other materials required to be completed and submitted by Tenderers.
- 3.3 The Tenderer shall fill in rates and prices for all items of the Works described in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates. Items for which no rate or price is entered by the Tenderer will not be paid for when executed and shall be deemed covered by the other rates and prices in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates. All duties, taxes and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract, as of 30 days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders, shall be included in the tender price submitted by the Tenderer.
- 3.4 The rates and prices quoted by the Tenderer shall not be subject to any adjustment in the initial 12 months period during the performance of the Contract.
- 3.5 The unit rates and prices shall be in Kenya Shillings.
- 2.6 Tenders shall remain valid for a period of hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of submission. However in exceptional circumstances, the County Government of Lamu may request for additional period. The request and the Tenderers' responses shall be made in writing.
- 3.6 The Tenderer shall prepare one original and one copy of the documents comprising the tender documents as described in these Instructions to Tenderers.
- 3.7 The original shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer. All pages of the tender where alterations or additions have been made shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the tender.
- 3.8 Clarification of tenders shall be requested by the tenderer to be received by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT not later than 7 days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders.

3.9 The County Government of Lamu shall reply to any clarifications sought by the tenderer within 3 days of receiving the request to enable the tenderer to make timely submission of its tender.

4. Submission of Tenders

4.1 The tender duly filled and sealed in an envelope shall;-

(a) be addressed to the County Government of Lamu at the address provided in the invitation to tender;

[b] Bear the name and identification number of the Contract/tender number as defined in the invitation to tender; and

[c] Provide a warning not to open before the specified time and date for tender opening.

4.2 Tenders shall be delivered to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT at the address specified above not later than the time and date specified in the invitation to tender.

4.3 The tenderer shall not submit any alternative offers unless they are specifically required in the tender documents.

Only one tender may be submitted by each tenderer. Any tenderer who fails to comply with this requirement will be disqualified.

4.4 Any tender received after the deadline for opening tenders will be returned to the tenderer un-opened.

4.5 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT may extend the deadline for submission of tenders by issuing an amendment in accordance with sub-clause 2.5 in which case all rights and obligations of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and the Tenderers previously subject to the original deadline will then be subject to the new deadline.

4.6 Tender security SHALL be in the equivalent of 2% of the total tender amount. Any bidder providing a bid bond less than the required amount will

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be disqualified. And be in cash, banker's cheque, Insurance or any other form easily convertible.

5. Tender Opening and Evaluation

5.1 The tenders will be opened in the presence of the Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend on **Thursday 16th May, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.**

5.2 The Tenderers' names, the total amount of each tender and such other details as may be considered appropriate, will be announced at the opening by the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT. Minutes of the tender opening, including the information disclosed to those present will also be prepared by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT

5.3 Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of tenders and recommendations for the award of the Contract shall not be disclosed to Tenderers or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Tenderer has been announced. Any effort by a Tenderer to influence the Lamu County Government officials, processing of tenders or award decisions may result in the rejection of his tender.

5.4 Tenders determined to be substantially responsive will be accepted. As provided under section 82 of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015, There SHALL be no correction of errors.

5.5 The tender evaluation committee shall evaluate the tender within 30 days of the validity period from the date of opening the tender.

5.6 Contract price variations shall not be allowed for contracts not exceeding one year (12 months)

5.7 Where contract price variation is allowed, the cumulative value for all contract do not result in an increment of the total contract price by more than twenty five (25%) of the original contract price, and SHALL be considered after 12 months from the date of contract signing, and shall be executed within the period of the contract.

5.8 Price variation requests shall be processed by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT within 30 days of receiving the request.

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5.9 Exclusive Preference SHALL be given to citizens of Kenya where the funding is 100% from the National Government or County Government or a Kenyan Body and the amount prescribed SHALL be above five hundred million.

5.10 To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of tenders, the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT at his discretion, may request [in writing] any Tenderer for clarification of the tender, including breakdowns of unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile but no change in the tender price or substance of the tender shall be sought, offered or permitted.

5.11 The Tenderer shall not influence LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT on any matter relating to his tender from the time of the tender opening to the time the Contract is awarded. Any effort by the Tenderer to influence LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT or his employees in his decision on tender evaluation, tender comparison or Contract award may result in the rejection of the tender.

6. Award of Contract

6.1 The award of the Contract will be made to the Tenderer with highest combined scorer who has offered the most competitive price.

6.2 Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 6.1 above, LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT reserves the right to accept or reject any tender and to cancel the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to the award of Contract without thereby

Incurring any liability to the affected Tenderer or Tenderers or any obligation to inform the affected Tenderer or Tenderers of the grounds for the action.

6.3 The Tenderer whose tender has been accepted will be notified of the award prior to expiration of the tender validity period in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile. This notification (hereinafter and in all Contract documents called the “Letter of Acceptance”) will state the sum [hereinafter and in all Contract documents called the “Contract Price” which LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution, completion, and maintenance of the Works by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract. The contract shall be formed on the parties signing the contract. At the same time the other tenderers shall be informed that their tenders have not been successful.

6.4 The Contract Agreement will incorporate all agreements between LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and the successful Tenderer. It will be signed by the County and sent to the successful Tenderer, within 30 days following the notification of award. Within 30 days of receipt, the successful Tenderer will sign the Agreement and return it to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT

6.5 Within 14 days after receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the successful Tenderer shall deliver to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT a Performance Security equivalent to 10% of the tender amount as stipulated in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract.

6.6 The parties to the contract shall have it signed within 30 days from the date of notification of contract award unless there is an administrative review request.

6.7 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT may at any time terminate procurement proceedings before contract award and shall not be liable to any person for the termination.

6.8 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT shall give prompt notice of the termination to the tenderers and (on request) shall give its reasons for termination within 14 day of receiving the request from any tenderer.

7. Corrupt and fraudulent practices

7.1 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT requires that the tenderer observes the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and execution of the contract. A tenderer shall sign a declaration that he has not and will not be involved in corrupt and fraudulent practices.

7.2 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT will reject a tender if it determines that the tenderer recommended for award has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

7.3 Further a tenderer who is found to have indulged in corrupt and fraudulent practices risks being debarred from participating in public procurement in Kenya.

SECTION III CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

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SECTION III - CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Definitions

1.1 In this Contract, except where context otherwise requires, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated;

“Bills of Quantities” means the priced and completed Bill of Quantities forming part of the tender [where applicable].

“Schedule of Rates” means the priced Schedule of Rates forming part of the tender [where applicable].

“The Completion Date” means the date of completion of the Works as certified by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT Representative.

“The Contract” means the agreement entered into by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and the Contractor as recorded in the Agreement Form and signed by the parties.

“The Contractor” refers to the person or corporate body whose tender to carry out the Works has been accepted by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

“The Contractor’s Tender” is the completed tendering document submitted by the Contractor to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT

“The Contract Price” is the price stated in the Letter of Acceptance.

“Days” are calendar days; **“Months”** are calendar months.

“A Defect” is any part of the Works not completed in accordance with the Contract.

“The Defects Liability Certificate” is the certificate issued by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT Representative upon correction of defects by the Contractor.

“The Defects Liability Period” is the period named in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract and calculated from the Completion Date.

“Drawings” include calculations and other information provided or approved by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT’S Representative for the execution of the Contract.

“Lamu water and Sewerage Company-LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT” is the Water service provider in Lamu county and party who employs the Contractor to carry out the Works.

“Equipment” is the Contractor’s machinery and vehicles brought temporarily to the Site for the execution of the Works.

“Site” means the place or places where the permanent Works are to be carried out including workshops where the same is being prepared.

“Materials” are all supplies, including consumables, used by the Contractor for incorporation in the Works.

“LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT’S Representative” is the person appointed by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and notified to the Contractor for the purpose of supervision of the Works.

“Specification” means the Specification of the Works included in the Contract.

“Start Date” is the date when the Contractor shall commence execution of the Works.

“A Subcontractor” is a person or corporate body who has a Contract with the Contractor to carry out a part of the Work in the Contract, which includes Work on the Site.

“Temporary works” are works designed, constructed, installed, and removed by the Contractor which are needed for construction or installation of the Works.

“A Variation” is an instruction given by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT Representative which varies the Works.

“The Works” are what the Contract requires the Contractor to construct, install, and turnover to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT

2. Contract Documents

2.1 The following documents shall constitute the Contract documents and shall be interpreted in the following order of priority;

- (1) Agreement,
- (2) Letter of Acceptance,
- (3) Contractor's/form of Tender,
- (4) Conditions of Contract,
- (5) Specifications,
- (6) Drawings,
- (7) Bills of Quantities or Schedule of Rates [whichever is applicable]
- (8) Performance guarantee

3. LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT'S Representative's Decisions

3.1 Except where otherwise specifically stated, the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative will decide contractual matters between LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and the Contractor in the role representing LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT

4. Works, Language and Law of Contract

4.1 The Contractor shall construct and install the Works in accordance with the Contract documents. The Works may commence on the Start Date and shall be carried out in accordance with the Program submitted by the Contractor, as updated with the approval of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative, and complete them by the Intended Completion Date.

4.2 The ruling language of the Contract shall be English language and the law governing the Contract shall be the law of the Republic of Kenya.

5. Safety, Temporary works and Discoveries

5.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for design of temporary works and shall obtain approval of third parties to the design of the temporary works where required.

5.2 The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of all activities on the Site.

5.3 Any thing of historical or other interest or significant value unexpectedly discovered on the Site shall be the property of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT. The Contractor shall notify the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative of such discoveries and carry out LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative's instructions for dealing with them.

6 Work Program and Sub-contracting

6.1 Within seven days after Site possession date, the Contractor shall submit to the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative for approval a program showing the general methods, arrangements, order and timing for all the activities in the Works.

6.2 The Contractor may sub-contract the Works (but only to a maximum of 25 percent of the Contract Price) with the approval LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative. However, he shall not assign the Contract without the approval of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT in writing. Subcontracting shall not alter the Contractor's obligations.

7 The site

7.1 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT shall give possession of all parts of the Site to the Contractor.

7.2 The Contractor shall allow LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative and any other person authorized by the LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative, access to the Site and to any place where work in connection with the Contract is being carried out or is intended to be carried out.

8 Instructions

8.1 The Contractor shall carry out all instructions of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative which are in accordance with the Contract.

9 Extension of Completion Date

9.1 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall extend the Completion Date if an occurrence arises which makes it impossible for completion to be achieved by the Intended Completion Date. LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENTS's Representative shall decide whether and by how much to extend the Completion Date.

9.2 For the purposes of this clause, the following occurrences shall be valid for consideration;

Delay by:-

- (a) force majeure, or
- (b) reason of any exceptionally adverse weather conditions, or
- (c) reason of civil commotion, strike or lockout affecting any of the trades employed upon the Works or any of the trades engaged in the preparation, manufacture or transportation of any of the goods or materials required for the Works, or
- (d) reason of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative's Instructions issued under these Conditions, or
- (e) reason of the contractor not having received in due time necessary instructions, drawings, details or levels from LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative for which he specifically applied in writing on a date which having regard to the date for Completion stated in the appendix to these Conditions or to any extension of time then fixed under this clause was neither unreasonably distant from nor unreasonably close to the date on which it was necessary for him to receive the same, or
- (f) delay on the part of artists, tradesmen or others engaged by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT in executing work not forming part of this Contract, or
- (g) reason of delay by statutory or other services providers or similar bodies engaged directly by Lamu County Government or
- (h) reason of opening up for inspection of any Work covered up or of the testing or any of the Work, materials or goods in accordance with these conditions unless the inspection or test showed that the Work, materials or goods were not in accordance with this Contract, or
- (i) reason of delay in appointing a replacement LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative, or
- (j) reason of delay caused by the late supply of goods or materials or in executing Work for which LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT or his agents are contractually obliged to supply or to execute as the case may be, or
- (k) Delay in receiving possession of or access to the Site.

10 Management Meetings

- 10.1A Contract management meeting shall be held regularly and attended by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative and the Contractor. Its business shall be to review the plans for the remaining Work. LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall record the business of management meetings and provide copies of the record to those attending the meeting and LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT. The responsibility of the parties for actions to be taken shall be decided by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative either at the management meeting or after the management meeting and stated in writing to all who attend the meeting.
- 10.2 Communication between parties shall be effective only when in writing.

11 Defects

- 11.1 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall inspect the Contractor's work and notify the Contractor of any defects that are found. Such inspection shall not affect the Contractor's responsibilities. The LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's representative may instruct the Contractor to search for a defect and to uncover and test any Work that LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT may consider to have a defect. Should the defect be found, the cost of uncovering/ and making well shall be borne by the Contractor. However if there is no defect found, the cost of uncovering and making good shall be treated as a variation and added to the Contract Price.
- 11.2 LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall give notice to the Contractor of any defects before the end of the Defects Liability Period, which begins at Completion, and is defined in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract.
- 11.3 Every time notice of a defect is given, the Contractor shall correct the notified defect within the length of time specified by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative's notice. If the Contractor has not corrected a defect within the time specified in LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative's notice, LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative will assess the cost of having the defect corrected by other parties and such cost shall be treated as a variation and be deducted from the Contract Price.

12 Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates

- 12.1 The Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates shall contain items for the construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the Work to be done by the Contractor.

The Contractor will be paid for the quantity of the Work done at the rates in the Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates for each item. Items against which no rate is entered by the Tenderer will not be paid for when executed and shall be deemed covered by the rates for other items in the Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates.

12.2 Where Bills of Quantities do not form part of the Contract, the Contract Price shall be a lump sum (which shall be deemed to have been based on the rates in the Schedule of Rates forming part of the tender) and shall be subject to re-measurement after each stage.

13 Variations

13.1 The Contractor shall provide LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative with a quotation for carrying out the variations when requested to do so. The LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall assess the quotation and shall obtain the necessary authority from LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT before the variation is ordered.

13.2 If the Work in the variation corresponds with an item description in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates, the rate in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates shall be used to calculate the value of the variation. If the nature of the Work in the variation does not correspond with items in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates, the quotation by the Contractor shall be in the form of new rates for the relevant items of Work.

13.3 If the Contractor's quotation is unreasonable, LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative may order the variation and make a change to the Contract Price, which shall be based on LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative's own forecast of the effects of the variation on the Contractor's costs.

14 Payment Certificates and Final Account

14.1 The Contractor shall be paid after each of the following stages of Work listed here below (subject to re-measurement by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative of the Work done in each stage before payment is made). In case of lump-sum Contracts, the valuation for each stage shall be based on the quantities so obtained in the re-measurement and the rates in the Schedule of Rates.

- (i) Advance payment _____ (*percent of Contract Price, [after Contract execution] to be inserted by the County Government of Lamu*).

- (d) LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative gives notice that failure to correct a particular defect is a fundamental breach of Contract and the Contractor fails to correct it within a reasonable period of time.

18.2 If the Contract is terminated, the Contractor shall stop Work immediately, and leave the Site as soon as reasonably possible. LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall immediately thereafter arrange for a meeting for the purpose of taking record of the Works executed and materials, goods, equipment and temporary buildings on Site.

19. Payment upon Termination

19.3 Until after completion of the Works under this clause, LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT shall not be bound by any other provision of this Contract to make any payment to the Contractor, but upon such completion as aforesaid and the verification within a reasonable time of the accounts therefor LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT's Representative shall certify the amount of expenses properly incurred by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT and, if such amount added to the money paid to the Contractor before such determination exceeds the total amount which would have been payable on due completion in accordance with this Contract, the difference shall be a debt payable to LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT by the Contractor; and if the said

amount added to the said money be less than the said total amount, the difference shall be a debt payable by LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT to the Contractor.

20. Corrupt Gifts and Payments of Commission

20.1 The Contractor shall not;

- (a) Offer or give or agree to give to any person in the service of LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT any gifts or consideration of any kind as an inducement or reward for doing or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of this or any other contract with LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT or for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavor to any person in relation to this or any other contract with LAMU COUNTY GOVERNMENT
- (b) Any breach of this Condition by the Contractor or by anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Contractor) shall be an offence under the Laws of Kenya.

21. Settlement of Disputes

21.1 Any dispute arising out of the Contract which cannot be amicably settled between the parties shall be referred by either party to the arbitration and final decision of a person to be agreed between the parties. Failing agreement to concur in the appointment of an Arbitrator, the Arbitrator shall be appointed by the chairman of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, Kenya branch, on the request of the applying party.
