- 1.3 A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested candidates upon payment of non-refundable fees of (Kshs.1, 000.00) in cash or Bankers Cheque payable to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU, Kenya Commercial Bank Lamu Branch, Acc NO. 1140750615 or Equity Bank Lamu Branch Acc. No. 1590265264918 Complete set of documents can also be downloaded from our website at www.lamu.go.ke free of charge.
- 1.4 Prices quoted should be net inclusive of all taxes, must be in Kenya shillings and shall remain valid for 120 days from the closing date of tender.
- 1.5 Completed tender documents are to be addressed to (COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU P.O BOX 74- 80500 LAMU and should be submitted electronically through IFMIS supplier portal at www.supplier.treasury.go.ke so as to be received on or before Wednesday 08th January, 2020 at 11.00 a.m.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS.

- 1.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU as defined in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract invites tenders for Works Contract as described in the tender documents and should complete the Works by the Intended Completion Date specified in the said Appendix.
- 1.2Tenderers shall include the following information and documents with their tenders, unless otherwise stated:
- 1.3The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.
- 1.4The Tenderer, at the Tenderer's own responsibility and risk, is encouraged to visit and examine the Site of the Works and its surroundings, and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the tender and entering into a contract for construction of the Works. The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Tenderer's own expense.
- 1.5The procurement entity's employees, committee members, board members and their relative (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the tender.
- 1.6 The price to be charged for the tender document shall not exceed Kshs.5, 000/=
- 1.7The County Government of Lamu shall allow the tenderer to review the tender document free of charge before purchase.

2. Tender Documents

2.1The complete set of tender documents comprises the documents listed here below and any addenda issued in accordance with clause 2.4 here below:-

- (a) These instructions to Tenderers
- (b) Form of Tender
- (c) Conditions of Contract and Appendix to Conditions of Contract
- (d) Specifications
- (e) Drawings
- (f) Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates (whichever is applicable)
- (g) Other materials required to be filled and submitted in accordance with these Instructions and Conditions
- 2.2 The Tenderer shall examine all instructions, forms and specifications in the tender documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the tender documents may result in rejection of his tender.
- 2.3 Prospective Tenderer making inquiries of the tendering documents may notify County Government of Lamu in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile at the address indicated in the letter of invitation to tender. County Government of Lamu will respond to any request for clarification received earlier than seven [7] days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. Copies of the County Government of Lamu response will be forwarded to all persons issued with tendering documents, including a description of the inquiry, but without identifying its source.
- 2.4 Before the deadline for submission of tenders, County Government of Lamu may modify the tendering documents by issuing addenda. Any addendum thus issued shall be part of the tendering documents and shall be communicated in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile to all Tenderers. Prospective Tenderers shall acknowledge receipt of each addendum in writing to the County Government of Lamu
- 2.5 To give prospective Tenderers reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their tenders, County Government of Lamu shall extend, as necessary, the deadline for submission of tenders in accordance with clause 4.2 here below.

3. Preparation of Tenders

- 3.1All documents relating to the tender and any correspondence shall be in English Language.
- 3.2 The tender submitted by the Tenderer shall comprise the following:-
 - (a) The Tender:

- (b) Tender Security;
- (c) Priced Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates for lump-sum Contracts
- (d) Any other materials required to be completed and submitted by Tenderers.
- 3.3 The Tenderer shall fill in rates and prices for all items of the Works described in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates. Items for which no rate or price is entered by the Tenderer will not be paid for when executed and shall be deemed covered by the other rates and prices in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates. All duties, taxes and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract, as of 30 days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders, shall be included in the tender price submitted by the Tenderer.
- 3.4 The rates and prices quoted by the Tenderer shall not be subject to any adjustment in the initial 12 months period during the performance of the Contract.
- 3.5 The unit rates and prices shall be in Kenya Shillings.
- 2.6 Tenders shall remain valid for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of submission. However in exceptional circumstances, the County Government of Lamu may add additional period. The request and the Tenderers' responses shall be made in writing.
- 3.6 The Tenderer shall prepare one original and one copy of the documents comprising the tender documents as described in these Instructions to Tenderers.
- 3.7 The original shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer. All pages of the tender where alterations or additions have been made shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the tender.
- 3.8 Clarification of tenders shall be requested by the tenderer to be received by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU not later than 7 days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders.

3.9 The County Government of Lamu shall reply to any clarifications sought by the tenderer within 3 days of receiving the request to enable the tenderer to make timely submission of its tender.

4. Submission of Tenders

- 4.1 The tender duly filled and sealed in an envelope shall;-
- (a) be addressed to the County Government of Lamu at the address provided in the invitation to tender;
- [b] Bear the name and identification number of the Contract/tender number as defined in the invitation to tender; and
- [c] Provide a warning not to open before the specified time and date for tender opening.
- 4.2 Tenders shall be delivered to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU at the address specified above not later than the time and date specified in the invitation to tender.
- 4.3 The tenderer shall not submit any alternative offers unless they are specifically required in the tender documents.
 - Only one tender may be submitted by each tenderer. Any tenderer who fails to comply with this requirement will be disqualified.
- 4.4 Any tender received after the deadline for opening tenders will be returned to the tenderer un-opened.
- 4.5 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may extend the deadline for submission of tenders by issuing an amendment in accordance with subclause 2.5 in which case all rights and obligations of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and the Tenderers previously subject to the original deadline will then be subject to the new deadline.
- 4.6 Tender security SHALL be in the equivalent of 2% of the total tender amount. Any bidder providing a bid bond less than the required amount will be disqualified. And be in cash, banker's cheque, Insurance or any other form easily convertible.

5. Tender Opening and Evaluation

- 5.1The tenders will be opened in the presence of the Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend on **Wednesday 08**th **January, 2020 at 11.00 a.m.**
- 5.2The Tenderers' names, the total amount of each tender and such other details as may be considered appropriate, will be announced at the opening by the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU. Minutes of the tender opening, including the information disclosed to those present will also be prepared by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU
- 5.3Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of tenders and recommendations for the award of the Contract shall not be disclosed to Tenderers or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Tenderer has been announced. Any effort by a Tenderer to influence the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU officials, processing of tenders or award decisions may result in the rejection of his tender.
- 5.4Tenders determined to be substantially responsive will be accepted. As provided under section 82 of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015, There SHALL be no correction of errors.
- 5.5The tender evaluation committee shall evaluate the tender within 30 days of the validity period from the date of opening the tender.
- 5.6Contract price variations shall not be allowed for contracts not exceeding one year (12 months)
- 5.7Where contract price variation is allowed, the cumulative value for all contract do not result in an increment of the total contract price by more than twenty five (25%) of the original contract price, and SHALL be considered after 12 months from the date of contract signing, and shall be executed within the period of the contract.
- 5.8Price variation requests shall be processed by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU within 30 days of receiving the request.
- 5.9Exclusive Preference SHALL be given to citizens of Kenya where the funding is 100% from the National Government or County Government or a Kenyan Body and the amount prescribed SHALL be above five hundred million.

- 5.10To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of tenders, the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU at his discretion, may request [in writing] any Tenderer for clarification of the tender, including breakdowns of unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile but no change in the tender price or substance of the tender shall be sought, offered or permitted.
- 5.11The Tenderer shall not influence COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU on any matter relating to his tender from the time of the tender opening to the time the Contract is awarded. Any effort by the Tenderer to influence COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU or his employees in his decision on tender evaluation, tender comparison or Contract award may result in the rejection of the tender.

6. Award of Contract

- 6.1The award of the Contract will be made to the Tenderer who has offered the most competitive bid and who will be determined to be the highest combined scorer.
- 6.2Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 6.1 above, COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU reserves the right to accept or reject any tender and to cancel the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to the award of Contract without thereby

incurring any liability to the affected Tenderer or Tenderers or any obligation to inform the affected Tenderer or Tenderers of the grounds for the action.

- 6.3The Tenderer whose tender has been accepted will be notified of the award prior to expiration of the tender validity period in writing or by cable, telex or facsimile. This notification (hereinafter and in all Contract documents called the "Letter of Acceptance") will state the sum [hereinafter and in all Contract documents called the "Contract Price" which COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution, completion, and maintenance of the Works by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract. The contract shall be formed on the parties signing the contract. At the same time the other tenderers shall be informed that their tenders have not been successful.
- 6.4The Contract Agreement will incorporate all agreements between COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and the successful Tenderer. It will be signed by the County and sent to the successful Tenderer, within 30 days following the notification of award. Within 30 days of receipt, the successful Tenderer will sign the Agreement and return it to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU
- 6.5Within 14 days after receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the successful Tenderer shall deliver to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU a Performance Security equivalent to 10% of the tender amount as stipulated in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract.
- 6.6The parties to the contract shall have it signed within 30 days from the date of notification of contract award unless there is an administrative review request.
- 6.7 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may at any time terminate procurement proceedings before contract award and shall not be liable to any person for the termination.
- 6.8 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall give prompt notice of the termination to the tenderers and (on request) shall give its reasons for termination within 14 day of receiving the request from any tenderer.

7. Corrupt and fraudulent practices

7.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU requires that the tenderer observes the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and execution of

- the contract. A tenderer shall sign a declaration that he has not and will not be involved in corrupt and fraudulent practices.
- 7.2 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU will reject a tender if it determines that the tenderer recommended for award has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.
- 7.3Further a tenderer who is found to have indulged in corrupt and fraudulent practices risks being debarred from participating in public procurement in Kenya.

SECTION III - CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. **Definitions**

- 1.1In this Contract, except where context otherwise requires, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated;
 - "Bills of Quantities" means the priced and completed Bill of Quantities forming part of the tender [where applicable].
 - "Schedule of Rates" means the priced Schedule of Rates forming part of the tender [where applicable].
 - **"The Completion Date" means** the date of completion of the Works as certified by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU Representative.
 - **"The Contract"** means the agreement entered into by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and the Contractor as recorded in the Agreement Form and signed by the parties.
 - "The Contractor" refers to the person or corporate body whose tender to carry out the Works has been accepted by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU.
 - "The Contractor's Tender" is the completed tendering document submitted by the Contractor to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU
 - "The Contract Price" is the price stated in the Letter of Acceptance.
 - "Days" are calendar days; "Months" are calendar months.
 - "A Defect" is any part of the Works not completed in accordance with the Contract.
 - "The Defects Liability Certificate" is the certificate issued by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU Representative upon correction of defects by the Contractor.
 - "The Defects Liability Period" is the period named in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract and calculated from the Completion Date.

- **"Drawings"** include calculations and other information provided or approved by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU'S Representative for the execution of the Contract.
- "Lamu water and Sewerage Company-COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU" is the Water service provider in Lamu county and party who employs the Contractor to carry out the Works.
- **"Equipment"** is the Contractor's machinery and vehicles brought temporarily to the Site for the execution of the Works.
- "Site" means the place or places where the permanent Works are to be carried out including workshops where the same is being prepared.
- "Materials" are all supplies, including consumables, used by the Contractor for incorporation in the Works.
- "COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU'S Representative" is the person appointed by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and notified to the Contractor for the purpose of supervision of the Works.
- "Specification" means the Specification of the Works included in the Contract.
- **"Start Date" is** the date when the Contractor shall commence execution of the Works.
- "A Subcontractor" is a person or corporate body who has a Contract with the Contractor to carry out a part of the Work in the Contract, which includes Work on the Site.
- "Temporary works" are works designed, constructed, installed, and removed by the Contractor which are needed for construction or installation of the Works.
- **"A Variation" is** an instruction given by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU Representative which varies the Works.
- "The Works" are what the Contract requires the Contractor to construct, install, and turnover to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU

2. Contract Documents

- 2.1 The following documents shall constitute the Contract documents and shall be interpreted in the following order of priority;
 - (1) Agreement,
 - (2) Letter of Acceptance,
 - (3) Contractor's/form of Tender,
 - (4) Conditions of Contract,
 - (5) Specifications,
 - (6) Drawings,
 - (7) Bills of Quantities or Schedule of Rates [whichever is applicable)
 - (8) Performance guarantee

3. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU'S Representative's Decisions

3.1Except where otherwise specifically stated, the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative will decide contractual matters between COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and the Contractor in the role representing COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU

4. Works, Language and Law of Contract

- 4.1The Contractor shall construct and install the Works in accordance with the Contract documents. The Works may commence on the Start Date and shall be carried out in accordance with the Program submitted by the Contractor, as updated with the approval of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative, and complete them by the Intended Completion Date.
- 4.2The ruling language of the Contract shall be English language and the law governing the Contract shall be the law of the Republic of Kenya.

5. Safety, Temporary works and Discoveries

- 5.1The Contractor shall be responsible for design of temporary works and shall obtain approval of third parties to the design of the temporary works where required.
- 5.2 The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of all activities on the Site.
- 5.3Any thing of historical or other interest or significant value unexpectedly discovered on the Site shall be the property of COUNTY GOVERNMENT

OF LAMU. The Contractor shall notify the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative of such discoveries and carry out COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative's instructions for dealing with them.

6Work Program and Sub-contracting

- 6.1Within seven days after Site possession date, the Contractor shall submit to the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative for approval a program showing the general methods, arrangements, order and timing for all the activities in the Works.
- 6.2The Contractor may sub-contract the Works (but only to a maximum of 25 percent of the Contract Price) with the approval COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative. However, he shall not assign the Contract without the approval of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU in writing. Subcontracting shall not alter the Contractor's obligations.

7The site

- 7.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall give possession of all parts of the Site to the Contractor.
- 7.2 The Contractor shall allow COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative and any other person authorized by the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative, access to the Site and to any place where work in connection with the Contract is being carried out or is intended to be carried out.

8Instructions

8.1The Contractor shall carry out all instructions of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative which are in accordance with the Contract.

9Extension of Completion Date

9.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall extend the Completion Date if an occurrence arises which makes it impossible for completion to be achieved by the Intended Completion Date. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMUS's Representative shall decide whether and by how much to extend the Completion Date.

9.2 For the purposes of this clause, the following occurrences shall be valid for consideration;

Delay by:-

- (a) force majeure, or
- (b) reason of any exceptionally adverse weather conditions, or
- (c) reason of civil commotion, strike or lockout affecting any of the trades employed upon the Works or any of the trades engaged in the preparation, manufacture or transportation of any of the goods or materials required for the Works, or
- (d) reason of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative's instructions issued under these Conditions, or
- (e) reason of the contractor not having received in due time necessary instructions, drawings, details or levels from COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative for which he specifically applied in writing on a date which having regard to the date for Completion stated in the appendix to these Conditions or to any extension of time then fixed under this clause was neither unreasonably distant from nor unreasonably close to the date on which it was necessary for him to receive the same, or
- (f) delay on the part of artists, tradesmen or others engaged by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU in executing work not forming part of this Contract, or
- (g) reason of delay by statutory or other services providers or similar bodies engaged directly by Lamu County or
- (h) reason of opening up for inspection of any Work covered up or of the testing or any of the Work, materials or goods in accordance with these conditions unless the inspection or test showed that the Work, materials or goods were not in accordance with this Contract, or
- (i) reason of delay in appointing a replacement COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative, or
- (j) reason of delay caused by the late supply of goods or materials or in executing Work for which COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU

or his agents are contractually obliged to supply or to execute as the case may be, or

(k) Delay in receiving possession of or access to the Site.

10Management Meetings

- 10.1A Contract management meeting shall be held regularly and attended by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative and the Contractor. Its business shall be to review the plans for the remaining Work. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall record the business of management meetings and provide copies of the record to those attending the meeting and COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU. The responsibility of the parties for actions to be taken shall be decided by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative either at the management meeting or after the management meeting and stated in writing to all who attend the meeting.
- 10.2 Communication between parties shall be effective only when in writing.

11Defects

- 11.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMUS's Representative shall inspect the Contractor's work and notify the Contractor of any defects that are found. Such inspection shall not affect the Contractor's responsibilities. The COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's representative may instruct the Contractor to search for a defect and to uncover and test any Work that COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may considers to have a defect. Should the defect be found, the cost of uncovering/ and making well shall be borne by the Contractor. However if there is no defect found, the cost of uncovering and making good shall be treated as a variation and added to the Contract Price.
- 11.2 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall give notice to the Contractor of any defects before the end of the Defects Liability Period, which begins at Completion, and is defined in the Appendix to Conditions of Contract.
- 11.3Every time notice of a defect is given, the Contractor shall correct the notified defect within the length of time specified by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative's notice. If the Contractor has not corrected a defect within the time specified in COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative's notice, COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's

Representative will assess the cost of having the defect corrected by other parties and such cost shall be treated as a variation and be deducted from the Contract Price.

12Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates

- 12.1The Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates shall contain items for the construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the Work to be done by the Contractor. The Contractor will be paid for the quantity of the Work done at the rates in the Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates for each item. Items against which no rate is entered by the Tenderer will not be paid for when executed and shall be deemed covered by the rates for other items in the Bills of Quantities/Schedule of Rates.
- 12.2Where Bills of Quantities do not form part of the Contract, the Contract Price shall be a lump sum (which shall be deemed to have been based on the rates in the Schedule of Rates forming part of the tender) and shall be subject to re-measurement after each stage.

13Variations

- 13.1The Contractor shall provide COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative with a quotation for carrying out the variations when requested to do so. The COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall assess the quotation and shall obtain the necessary authority from COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU before the variation is ordered.
- 13.2If the Work in the variation corresponds with an item description in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates, the rate in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates shall be used to calculate the value of the variation. If the nature of the Work in the variation does not correspond with items in the Bill of Quantities/Schedule of Rates, the quotation by the Contractor shall be in the form of new rates for the relevant items of Work.
- 13.3If the Contractor's quotation is unreasonable, COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative may order the variation and make a change to the Contract Price, which shall be based on COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's

Representative's own forecast of the effects of the variation on the Contractor's costs.

14 Payment Certificates and Final Account

14.1The Contractor shall be paid after each of the following stages of Work listed here below (subject to re-measurement by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's

Representative of the Work done in each stage before payment is made). In case of lump-sum Contracts, the valuation for each stage shall be based on the quantities so obtained in the re-measurement and the rates in the Schedule of Rates.

- 14.2 Upon deciding that Works included in a particular stage are complete, the Contractor shall submit to the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative his application for payment. The COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall check, adjust if necessary and certify the amount to be paid to the Contractor within 21 days of receipt of the Contractor's application .COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall pay the Contractor the amounts so certified within 30 days of the date of issue of each Interim Certificate.
- 14.3 The Contractor shall supply COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative with a detailed final account of the total amount that the Contractor considers payable under the Contract before the end of the Defects Liability Period. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall issue a Defect Liability Certificate and certify any final payment that is due to the Contractor within 30 days of receiving the Contractor's account if it is correct and complete. If it is not, COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall issue within 21 days a schedule that states the scope of the corrections or additions that are necessary. If the final account is still unsatisfactory after it has been resubmitted, the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall decide on the amount payable to the Contractor and issue a Final

Payment Certificate. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall pay the Contractor the amount so certified within 60 days of the issue of the Final Payment Certificate.

14.4 If the period laid down for payment to the Contractor upon each of the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative's Certificate by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU has been exceeded, the Contractor shall be entitled to claim simple interest calculated pro-rata on the basis of the number of days delayed at the

Central Bank of Kenya's average base lending rate prevailing on the first day the payment becomes overdue. The Contractor will be required to notify COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU within 15 days of receipt of delayed payments of his intentions to claim interest.

15. Insurance

15.1The Contractor shall be responsible for and shall take out appropriate cover against, among other risks, personal injury; loss of or damage to the Works, materials and plant; and loss of or damage to property.

16. Liquidated Damages

16.1The Contractor shall pay liquidated damages to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU at the rate 0.001 per cent of the Contract price per day for each day that the actual Completion Date is later than the Intended Completion Date except in the case of any of the occurrences listed under clause 9.2. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may deduct liquidated damages from payments due to the Contractor. Payment of liquidated damages shall not affect the Contractor's liabilities.

17. Completion and Taking Over

Upon deciding that the Work is complete the Contractor shall request the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative to issue a Certificate of Completion of the Works, upon deciding that the Work is completed.

COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall take over the Site and the Works within seven days of the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative issuing a Certificate of Completion.

18. Termination

- 18.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU or the Contractor may terminate the Contract if the other party causes a fundamental breach of the Contract. These fundamental breaches of Contract shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following;
 - (a) the Contractor stops Work for 30 days continuously without reasonable cause or authority from COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative;
 - (b) the Contractor is declared bankrupt or goes into liquidation other than for a reconstruction or amalgamation;
 - (c) A payment certified by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative is not paid by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU to the Contractor within 30 days after the expiry of the payment periods stated in sub clauses 14.2 and 14.3 hereinabove.
 - (d) COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative gives notice that failure to correct a particular defect is a fundamental breach of Contract and the Contractor fails to correct it within a reasonable period of time.
- 18.2If the Contract is terminated, the Contractor shall stop Work immediately, and leave the Site as soon as reasonably possible. COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall immediately thereafter arrange for a meeting for the purpose of taking record of the Works executed and materials, goods, equipment and temporary buildings on Site.

19. Payment upon Termination

- 19.1 COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may employ and pay other persons to carry out and complete the Works and to rectify any defects and may enter upon the Works and use all materials on Site, plant, equipment and temporary works.
- 19.2 The Contractor shall, during the execution or after the completion of the Works under this clause, remove from the Site as and when required within such reasonable time as COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative may in writing specify, any temporary buildings, plant, machinery, appliances, goods or materials belonging to him, and in default thereof,

COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU may (without being responsible for any loss or damage) remove and sell any such property of the Contractor, holding the proceeds less all costs incurred to the credit of the Contractor.

19.3 Until after completion of the Works under this clause, COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU shall not be bound by any other provision of this Contract to make any payment to the Contractor, but upon such completion as aforesaid and the verification within a reasonable time of the accounts therefor COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU's Representative shall certify the amount of expenses properly incurred by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU and, if such amount added to the money paid to the Contractor before such determination exceeds the total amount which would have been payable on due completion in accordance with this Contract, the difference shall be a debt payable to COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU by the Contractor; and if the said amount added to the said money be less than the said total amount, the difference shall be a debt payable by COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU to the Contractor.

20. Corrupt Gifts and Payments of Commission

20.1 The Contractor shall not;

- (a) Offer or give or agree to give to any person in the service of COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU any gifts or consideration of any kind as an inducement or reward for doing or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of this or any other contract with COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU or for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavor to any person in relation to this or any other contract with COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF LAMU
- (b) Any breach of this Condition by the Contractor or by anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Contractor) shall be an offence under the Laws of Kenya.

21. Settlement of Disputes

21.1Any dispute arising out of the Contract which cannot be amicably settled between the parties shall be referred by either party to the arbitration and final decision of a person to be agreed between the parties. Failing agreement to concur in the appointment of an Arbitrator, the Arbitrator shall be appointed by the chairman of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, Kenya branch, on the request of the applying party.


